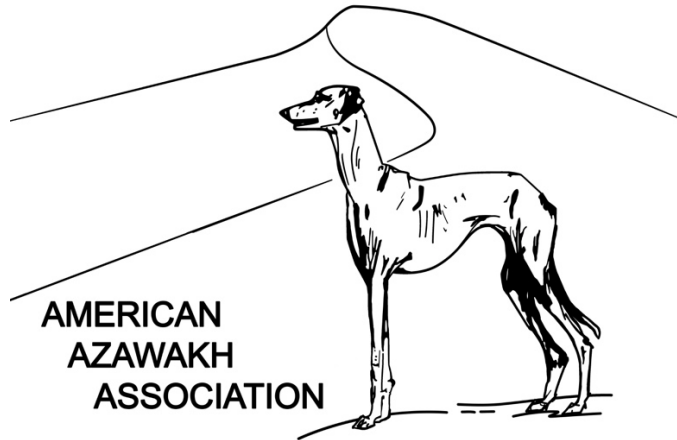

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This event is open to all dogs four (4) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. No Champions of Record may compete in an Open Show. No spayed or neutered dogs. Professional handlers or agents are only permitted to exhibit in FSS Open shows if they are listed as an owner of record of the dog being exhibited. Professional handlers are defined as *any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as a handling dogs for pay.*

Dogs should be physically sound. No dog shall be judged if it is taped, bandaged, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Entry Fees Per Day

Second Entry of same dog (Received before 6/30/17)	\$15.00
Day of show entry of each dog (1 hour before start of show)	\$25.00

Please make checks payable to the AAA. No entries will be accepted by phone, fax or email. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions to its acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

*Any exhibitor who allows his/her dogs to be loose and unattended in a room or to do damage to hotel property and who then does not immediately contact the hotel management to make proper restitution, will be subject to Event Committee action which could result in the loss of AKC privileges. This also applies to cleaning up after your dog at the hotel/motel grounds.

Routes to the Show Site

From the West: Take Interstate 90 East to Madison, Ohio Rt. 528 Exit (stay in right hand lane in construction area); head North on Rt. 528 to Chapel Rd. (Rt. 528 becomes Hubbard Rd. upon crossing Rt. 20 Intersection), turn left on Chapel Rd., drive approximately 1.8 miles. The show site is on the North side of Chapel Rd., or Take State Rt. 2 East until it ends at Rt. 20; follow Rt. 20 East to McMackin Rd.; turn left on McMackin Rd. to Chapel Rd.; turn right on Chapel Rd. to show grounds.

From the East: Take Interstate 90 West to Madison, Ohio, Rt. 528 Exit and follow the above directions.

Attention Exhibitors

Parking Notice: In case of inclement weather, ALL parking is at the discretion & risk of the owner/driver.

Limited Select Day Parking available at \$10.00 per day. Notify Parking Attendants.

All RV Parking Rules & Regulations will be strictly enforced.

Overnight Parking - All vehicles \$20.00 per day.

No hookups - no reservations required - first come, first served.

\$5.00 per vehicle General Parking per day. 3 Day Weekend Pass available for \$15.00.

The grounds will be available to exhibitors on **Wednesday, 3:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M.** and on

Thursday, Friday & Saturday, 6:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M.

Absolutely no admission to the grounds until 3:00 P.M., Wednesday.

All Whippet RVs will be across from the Whippet ring. You must notify the parking attendants that you are

there for the Whippet Specialty.

Overnight vehicles are parked on a first come, first served basis. If you want to park with someone, you must enter the grounds with them. No exceptions.

All overnight vehicles must be parked 15' apart – from side of vehicle to side of vehicle and 10' end to end. This will be enforced under Order of Lake County General Health District.

Any vehicle requiring sewage disposal may call 1-800-837-0050. Disposal will be at owner's expense. There are no disposal sites on the grounds.

All vehicles remaining on the grounds overnight will be assessed the overnight parking fee OF \$20.00 NO EXCEPTIONS!

All belongings must be removed from the show grounds by 6:00 P.M. Sunday.

Grooming tent available for exhibitors on first come, first served basis.

Absolutely no crates under tent or in ring aisles.

Catalogues are \$6.00 - Available at club tent in limited quantity.

Chairs cannot obstruct entrances to the tent.

Toy ring unloading must be accompanied without obstructing the roadway or the area designated as the toy ring unloading only.



AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
